RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO TO COOPERATE IN MIGRATING TOWARD A REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the current communication network of San Diego-Imperial County is nearing the end of its product life and relevance, and the current 'patch through' and 'work-around' method is cumbersome and outdated; and

WHEREAS, vendor support of the county's current 800 MHz system will end in approximately five years, making support for current infrastructure increasingly difficult to maintain; and

WHEREAS, this is an opportune time for City and County agencies to pursue the common goal of improving public safety through investment in a seamless regional public safety communications system with the capacity to support future growth; and

WHEREAS, the City and County have agreed to work in partnership to achieve the convergence of all radio systems to achieve full interoperability within the San Diego-Imperial County region; and

WHEREAS, the City and County commit to partnering in the planning of our region's new communications technology; establishing a collaborative and unified governance structure to manage the new communications system; jointly identifying and pursuing project funding; partnering in the implementation of the upgraded regional communication system; and achieving a truly interoperable and seamless Regional Public Safety Communications System NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to enter into an agreement with the County of San Diego to cooperate in migrating toward a Regional Public Safety Communications System.
- 2. That the Deputy Chief Operating Officer is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to administer and operate this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 3. This activity is not a 'project' and therefore exempt from CEQA pursuant to the State Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
