WHEREAS, Judy Case came to San Diego from the East Coast where she worked with the Young Women's Christian Association [YWCA] foundation as well as various other social service agencies; and

WHEREAS, Judy's eight year tenure at the San Diego YWCA was filled with economic challenges which she successfully overcame; and

WHEREAS, Judy was able to accomplish the construction and beginning of the Becky's House concept as transitional housing for victims of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, Becky's House has changed the face of the YWCA in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, Judy also began and will complete the construction of the second Becky's House here in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, Judy has lead the YWCA in adding approximately 100 transitional beds in our community for women and children of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, Judy was instrumental in creating the family homeless facility known as Cortez Hill which is owned by the City and operated by the YWCA; and houses between 100 and 150 homeless individuals at any given time; and

WHEREAS, Judy was able to lead the YWCA through the difficult and increasing constraints imposed by the Governor's Non-Profit Integrity Act which dramatically changed the landscape for non-profits by imposing increased liability on management and Boards; and

WHEREAS, Judy began at a time when the YWCA's annual luncheon know as "In The Company of Women" was just beginning; today, it is the largest annual luncheon for local non-profits with over 1600 in attendance last year; and

WHEREAS, the YWCA provided residential and counseling services for over 1300 individuals last year, which has more than doubled in Judy's tenure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby commend Judy Case for her passionate commitment and perseverance to the YWCA of San Diego and thanks her for the many hours she has devoted toward women and children who are victims of domestic violence.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that May 31, 2007, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "JUDY CASE DAY" in the City of San Diego.
