COMMEMORATION OF THE FOUNDING OF THE
SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT ON MAY 9TH,
1889

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Historical Association wishes to join with the City in commemorating the founding of the San Diego Police Department on May 9th, 1889; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Historical Association has offered to coordinate the purchasing, ordering, and issuing of a commemorative police badge to be bought by active duty officers of the San Diego Police Department; and


WHEREAS, individual officers will be given the option of purchasing, at their own expense, the commemorative police badge as a permanent keepsake; and

WHEREAS, the commemorative police badge will serve as a symbol of the pride and dedication of all sworn personnel; and

WHEREAS, only active duty officers will wear, if they so desire, the commemorative police badge instead of the official police badge, from May 1st through May 31st, 2007; NOW,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Police Chief be and is hereby authorized to allow only active duty officers to wear, if they so desire, the commemorative police badge instead of the official badge, from May 1st through May 31st, 2007
