## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-302600 DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 1 5 2007

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXERCISE OF AN OPTION WITH WESTON SOLUTIONS AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE FOR SUCH OPTION IN CONNECTION WITH THE STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007.

WHEREAS, on October 5, 2005, the Council adopted Resolution R-300905 and entered into an agreement with Weston Solutions, Inc. for as-needed professional services relating to water quality monitoring, stormwater management, and the City's compliance with the Clean Water Act and the stormwater laws and regulations established by the State Water Resources Control Board and the Regional Water Quality Control Board; and

WHEREAS, the agreement term was for one year and contained four additional one-year options whereby the City may elect to contract with Weston Solutions to perform same services in those subsequent years based on pre-established rates; and

WHEREAS, at this time the City's Stormwater Pollution and Prevention Division has a continuing need for the services provided by Weston Solutions foreseeably for the next fiscal year, and it is in the City's interest to presently exercise its option for one more contract year on the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the foreseeable needs for Weston Solutions' services in Fiscal Year 2007 are approximately \$1 million greater than in Fiscal Year 2006; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee are authorized to execute the remaining option in the Weston Solutions agreement for the next contract year using the Fiscal Year 2007 appropriation

(R-2007-975 Rev.)

provided herein, and as set forth in the First Amendment to Agreement in Exercise of Options,

on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-302600.

2. That the total maximum additional compensation to Weston Solutions during Fiscal

Year 2007 shall be \$3,140,000.

3. That the expenditure of a maximum amount not to exceed \$3,140,000 is authorized

from the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Operating Fund, Fund No. 100, for the sole purpose of

providing funds for Weston Solutions' services in Fiscal Year 2007.

4. That the subject of the remaining option years on the Weston Solutions agreement is

referred to the Natural Resources & Culture Committee for discussion prior to further Council

consideration.

5. That the above activity is not a project and is categorically exempt from the California

Environmental Quality Act as data collection, research, and resource evaluation activities that

do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource, pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines sections 15060(c)(2) and 15306.
