WHEREAS, Lou Scanlon joined the San Diego Police Department on December 20, 1974, as an officer working in Traffic Operations; and

WHEREAS, Lou Scanlon has held a number of Patrol and Investigative assignments including supervisory duties in Patrol, Investigations, Special Projects/Long Range Planning, Air Support, and SWAT; and

WHEREAS, Lou Scanlon has also headed the Public Affairs/Media Relations, Background Investigations/Hiring, and Equal Employment Units for the San Diego Police Department; and

WHEREAS, prior to his appointment to Assistant Chief, Lou Scanlon commanded the Western Division of the San Diego Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Lou Scanlon became Assistant Chief on March 17, 2001, where he oversaw patrol divisions and area detectives including Central, Eastern, Northeastern, Western, Northern, Mid-City, Southeastern and Southern Divisions as well as the following units: Internal Affairs Professional Standards Unit, Training and the Regional Academy, the Organizational

Effectiveness Division which includes Facilities Management, Management Analysis Strategic Management, SWAT, Canine, Air Support, Court Liaison Juvenile Administration, Media Relations Neighborhood Policing and Automotive Maintenance; and


