
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL INCREASING
CIP 68-010.0; AND TRANSFERRING AND EXPENDING
FUNDS FOR A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT BAYSIDE WALK /
WEST MISSION BAY DRIVE.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That in accordance with the annual appropriation ordinance, the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized and directed to amend the Fiscal Year 2007 Capital Improvement Program budget to increase CIP 68-010.0, Traffic Signals – Citywide, by the amount of \$150,000.
2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is further authorized to transfer the amount of \$150,000 from Fund No.10532, Belmont Park Traffic Amelioration Fund, to CIP 68-010.0, Traffic Signals – Citywide.
3. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$150,000 from CIP 68-010.0, Traffic Signals – Citywide, is authorized, solely and exclusively to provide funds to install a traffic signal on Bayside Walk and West Mission Bay Drive, provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for this expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.
4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves on advice of the administering department.

5. That the above activity is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA guideline section 15303, as the construction, installation or conversion of a small structure.


