A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD FROM THE CALIFORNIA AIR RESOURCES BOARD; AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND EXPENDITURE OF SUCH GRANT FUNDS FOR FILTERS ON DIESEL CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the California Air Resources Board [CARB] has made available to the City a grant of \$128,925 under the Purchase of Low Emission Construction Equipment by Public Agencies Program, subject to acceptance by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds would be used to acquire and install particulate matter filters on off-road diesel construction equipment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to accept, for and on behalf of the City, a grant award from CARB in the amount of \$128,925 under the terms and conditions set forth in Grant Number G06-PA26, Grant Award Agreement, the form of which is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Number RR- 302776.
- 2. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to accept and appropriate grant funds and to deposit same into Vehicle Replacement Fund No. 50031.
- 3. That upon the City's receipt of such funds and the executed grant agreement, the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$128,925 is authorized, solely and exclusively to reimburse the City for the acquisition and installation of particulate matter filters on off-road diesel construction equipment.

4. That the above activity is not a "project" subject to the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15060(c)(2) and 15382 because this activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect adverse physical change in the environment.
