WHEREAS, the Municipal Code also provides that members of the Board shall serve without compensation, for two-year terms and until a member's successor is duly appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, there are several vacancies on the Park and Recreation Board due to expired terms; NOW, THEREFORE,
