DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUL 27 2007

WHEREAS, the Commission for Arts and Culture [Commission] is established in San Diego Municipal Code section 26.0703 to advise the Mayor, City Council, and City Manager on promoting, encouraging, and increasing support for arts and culture, as well as to encourage the preservation and augmentation of the City of San Diego's cultural and artistic resources, and to ensure that the City's increasing urbanization is offset by the creation of artworks and venues dedicated to artistic performances, exhibitions, and cultural events; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the Commission shall consist of fifteen members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council who represent the following: individual artists, arts and culture patrons, educators, the business community, those with professional qualifications and experience or knowledge of a particular arts and culture field, and the general public; NOW, THEREFORE,
