A RESOLUTION CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, OR GENERAL WELFARE REQUIRES THE FORMATION OF UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICTS FOR THE LA JOLLA MESA VISTA COMMUNITY PLANNING AREA.

WHEREAS, Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code establishes a procedure for the creation of underground utility districts and requires as an initial step in such procedure the holding of a public hearing to determine whether the public health, safety, or general welfare requires removal of poles, overhead wires, and associated structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service in any such district; and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the following underground utility district be formed:

- a. Lots 2 through 31 & 33 through 52 of Map of La Jolla Mesa Vista Unit No.2
   Subdivision Map No. 4551
- b. Portion Lot 1 and Portion Lot 1782 of Pueblo Lands Partition CC 7634
- c. Parcel 1 of PM 17336
- d. Lot 1 of La Jolla Valley Vista Unit No. 3 Map 3742
- e. Lots 26 & 27 of La Jolla Valley Vista Unit No. 2 Map 3494

- f. Candlelight Dr. between a line from the Northeastern corner of 5565 Candlelight

  Dr. and to the Southeastern corner of 5572 Candlelight Dr. to the Northerly line of

  Candlelight Place.
- g. Lamplight Dr. between a line parallel to +/- 60 feet east of La Jolla Mesa Dr. to the westerly line of Candelight Dr.
- h. Moonlight Ln. between the southeasterly line of Candlelight Dr. to a line parallel to +/- 25 feet east of 5402 Moonlight Lane.; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit Attachment A, Map, and Exhibit Attachment B, Legal Description, depicts the above District with greater specificity; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of San Diego on SEP 10, 2007 at the hour of 2:00p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, California, to determine whether the public health, safety or general welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, community antenna television or similar or associated service in the District described above.
- 2. At such hearing, all persons interested shall be given an opportunity to be heard and the hearing may be continued from time to time as may be determined by the City Council. The decision of the City Council as to the formation of the Districts as described above shall be final and conclusive.

- 3. The Mayor shall notify all affected persons as defined in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code and each utility company concerned of the time and place of the hearing by following the procedure set forth in Chapter VI, Article 1, Division 5 of the San Diego Municipal Code.
- 4. That the Fiscal Year 2008 Capital Improvement Program Budget is amended by adding CIP No. 37-027.0, La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utilities Assessment District.
- 5. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to increase the Capital Improvements Program Budget for CIP No. 37-027.0, La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utilities Assessment District, Fund No. 30101, Underground Surcharge Fund, by \$380,000.
- 6. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to transfer \$380,000 from CIP No. 37-028.0, Annual Allocation of Undergrounding City Utilities, to CIP No. 37-027.0, La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utilities Assessment District, within Fund No. 30101, Underground Surcharge Fund.
- 7. That the appropriation and expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$380,000 from CIP No. 37-027.0, La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utilities Assessment District, Fund 30101, Underground Surcharge Fund, is authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of utility undergrounding and associated activities as described in the Engineers Report for La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utility Assessment District No. 4098., provided that the City Auditor and Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditures are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

- 8. That the Mayor is authorized to accept the \$10,000 from the La Jolla Mesa Vista Homeowners Association for the purpose of funding the proposed formation of the La Jolla Vista Mesa Undergrounding Utility Assessment District.
- 9. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to increase the Fiscal Year 2008 Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP 37-027.0, La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Assessment District, in Fund 63022, Private and Other Contributions- CIP.
- 10. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend \$10,000 from CIP 37-027.0, La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Assessment District, Fund 63022, Private and Other Contributions- CIP, for the purpose of the La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utilities project.
- 11. That the City Auditor and Comptroller, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.


