

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 302908

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE AUG 03 2007

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2007, the City Attorney's Office received notification that the City, upon application, will be awarded a \$59,395 grant from the State of California Department of Justice [DOJ] for Fiscal Year 2008 (July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008); and

WHEREAS, this grant money is from the Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program [SAPP]; and

WHEREAS, this amount will be supplemented with one-time augmentation of \$4,404 from the settlement of a case in the Attorney General's Office, for total SAPP funding to the City of \$63,799; and

WHEREAS, the SAPP grant requires a 20 percent match by the City, which has and will be met through existing staff salaries; and

WHEREAS, the SAPP grant requires a resolution that the grant will not be used to supplant local expenditures and the City will hold DOJ harmless from any claims that may arise from the use of SAPP grant monies; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Attorney is hereby authorized to apply for, accept and expend a \$59,395 Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program Grant and additional program funding of \$4,404 from the State of California Department of Justice under the terms and conditions outlined in the letter dated April 20, 2007 from California Attorney General Edmund G. Brown Jr., a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk's Office as Document No. RR - 302908

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a 20 percent match by the City has and will be met through existing staff salaries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Spousal Abuser Prosecution Program grant money will not be used to supplant local expenditures and the City will hold the California Department of justice harmless from any claims that may arise from the use of SAPP grant monies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney's Office is authorized to execute all aspects of the program operation, including any amendments, extensions, or renewals, provided funding is made available by the State of California, and that the City Attorney's Office will certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements related to this program.
