WHEREAS, San Diego Junior Theatre is the oldest continuing children's theatre program in the country with many celebrity alumni, including Victor Buono, Dennis Hopper, Raquel Welch and Brian Stokes Mitchell (the 1999 Tony award winner for Kiss Me Kate); and
