WHEREAS, The Ranch House at Del Sur features solar energy, low-emissions windows, EnergyStar appliances, a tankless water heater, dual-flush toilets, low-flow faucets, drought-resistant landscaping and a weather-based irrigation controller, which save approximately fifty-seven percent of energy annually and more than one million gallons of water a year; and

waste that are used for cabinets, countertops, ceilings and flooring and indoor air sensors to

monitor carbon dioxide, temperature, humidity and volatile organics in real-time over the

Internet to observe trends and allow for preventative action; and

WHEREAS, Fredric J. Maas is currently Chairman of the Centre City Development

Corporation's Board of Directors; he is also a founding Director of the San Diego Coalition for

Transportation Choices; NOW, THEREFORE,
