A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RATIFYING THE ELECTION RESULTS OF THE OCTOBER 2, 2007 PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE ELECTION FOR THE COLLEGE COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on September 22, 1992, the City Council of the City of San Diego
[Council], by Resolution No. R-280718, adopted the "Procedure for Formation of a Project Area
Committee for the College Community Redevelopment Project"; and

WHEREAS, on July 15, 2003, the Council, by Resolution No. R-298200, amended the Procedure for Formation of a Project Area Committee [PAC] for the College Community Redevelopment Project [Formation Procedures]; and

WHEREAS, on July 26, 2007, the Council, by Resolution No. R-302842, approved a one-year extension of the PAC for the College Community Redevelopment Project and directed the Redevelopment Agency staff to notice and conduct the annual PAC election for 2007; and

WHEREAS, after notice and in accordance with the Formation Procedures, the College Community Redevelopment Project PAC Bylaws approved on August 4, 1998, and applicable law, the annual PAC election was duly conducted by Agency staff on October 2, 2007; and

WHEREAS, a representative from the City Clerk's Office attended the annual PAC election to ensure its validity and provide official verification of the tallying of ballots; and

WHEREAS, the newly elected members of the PAC have submitted to the City Council information establishing the qualifications and eligibility of each member relative to district, category or organization as appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Redevelopment Project, including those persons who received the highest number of votes in their respective categories and listed on the City Clerk's Office's verification of election results

That the Project Area Committee [PAC] for the College Community

attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved as

constituting a representative PAC.

2. That the Council finds that the election results of October 2, 2007 are valid and

binding in accordance with the Formation Procedures adopted by Resolution No. 298200.

3. That this activity is not a "project" and is therefore not subject to the California

Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
