

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 303171

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 20 2007

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING A CONTINUED SHELTER CRISIS DUE TO THE WILDFIRES.

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 8630 authorizes local governing bodies to proclaim local emergencies when such events occur as are defined by California Government Code section 8558(c), provided further by Section 8630 that the local governing body must review the state of emergency at its regularly scheduled meetings or every twenty-one days until such emergency is declared to be terminated; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-303099 declaring the existence of a shelter crisis due to the wildfires which began on October 21, 2007, which led to the evacuation of City residents and a shortage of adequate shelter that resulted in a threat to their health and safety; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the shelter crisis continues to exist in the City of San Diego due to the wildfires; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to Government Code sections 8698 through 8698.2, a shelter crisis continues to exist in the City of San Diego due to the wildfires.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the measures previously taken by the City Council in Resolution No. R-303099 shall continue to have full force and effect.
