WHEREAS, Douglas Myers earned a Bachelor's Degree in Business and Psychology from Christopher Newport University in Newport News, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Myers was employed by the Anheuser-Busch Entertainment Corporation for eleven years, where he advanced from ride and tour supervisor to a variety of management positions; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Myers joined the Zoological Society of San Diego in 1982, as General Manager for the San Diego Wild Animal Park; and

WHEREAS, in 1983, Douglas Myers was quickly promoted to Deputy Director of Operations for both the San Diego Zoo and the Wild Animal Park; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Myers assumed the position of Executive Director of the Society in February of 1985, where he became the Chief Executive Officer of the organization; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Myers was recently confirmed by the United States Senate to serve on the National Museums and Library Services Board, which advises the Institute of Museum and Library Services, an independent deferral agency that is the primary source of federal support for the nation's museums and libraries; and

WHEREAS, Douglas Myers is currently a board member of the American Association of Museums and the National Institute of Museum Library Services; a member of the Balboa Park Cultural Partnership, the Central Balboa Park Association, the Rotary Club of San Diego, the California Association of Zoos and Aquariums and the Conservation Breeding Specialists Group


Steering Committee; and is a fellow of the Association of Zoos and Aquariums and the World Association of Zoos and Aquariums; and

WHEREAS, in the past, Douglas Myers has served as President of the Balboa Park Cultural Partnership and Chairman of the San Pasqual-Lake Hodges Planning Group; was a board member of the Transportation Management Association, Association of Zoos and Aquariums, the North County YMCA, the San Diego Convention and Visitors Bureau and the Advisory Council to the Museum Trustee Association; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby congratulate Douglas Myers on his confirmation to the National Museum and Library Services Board and commend him for his years of service to the San Diego community.
