

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 303189

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE DEC 0 5 2007

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council adopted an ordinance, codified at San Diego Municipal Code section 26.16, establishing the Citizens Equal Opportunity Commission; and

WHEREAS, section 26.16 provides that the Commission monitor and/or evaluate the City's Equal Opportunity Program; advise the Mayor, City Council, Civil Service Commission and other appropriate agencies; submit written quarterly reports for review by the City Council's Rules Committee and City Council; assist in recruiting competent, historically under-represented minorities, women and disabled to compete for City positions; and promote the City of San Diego as an Equal Opportunity Employer of individuals and firms desiring to contract with the City; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that the Commission shall consist of 11 members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that the board shall include one representative from each of the following historically underrepresented groups: Latino, African-American, Filipino, American Indian, Asian/Pacific Islander, Disabled and Lesbian/Gay/Bisexual/Transgender [LGBT]; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that the remaining four members of the commission shall be appointed from the City at large; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that members shall serve two-year terms; each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; and all terms must have expiration dates of January 1; and

WHEREAS, 10 of the 11 seats are now to be appointed or reappointed with members; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments and reappointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego to serve as members of the City of San Diego Citizens Equal Opportunity Commission, for a term ending as indicated, be and the same is hereby confirmed:
