WHEREAS, Girl Scouts San Diego-Imperial Council is celebrating its 90th anniversary during 2007; and

WHEREAS, Girl Scouts San Diego-Imperial Council has influenced the lives of five generations of girls – and now includes 40,000 girl and adult members; and

WHEREAS, Girl Scouts become strong leaders by setting and achieving personal goals, discovering their personal best, connecting with others in an increasingly diverse world and taking action to improve their communities; and

WHEREAS, Girl Scouting's long history in Balboa Park began in 1921 when the organization's headquarters was located in a single room in a Navy hospital building in the Pepper Grove – and has since been expanded to an 11-acre multi-purpose headquarters and campground site in the park; and

WHEREAS, Girl Scouts, San Diego-Imperial Council troops are actively involved in Balboa Park - where they earn the Junior Friends of Balboa Park patch, volunteer as greeters at December Nights, and where annually, in May, thousands of girls cross the Cabrillo Bridge together to symbolize their passage to the next level of scouting; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby congratulate Girl Scouts San Diego-Imperial Council on its 90th Anniversary and commend Girl Scouts for its contribution to the City of San Diego.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that October 23, 2007, be and is hereby proclaimed to be "GIRL SCOUTS DAY" in the City of San Diego.
