A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY RULE TO MAKE THE CHAIR OF THE RULES, OPEN GOVERNMENT AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT PRO TEM.

WHEREAS, Rule 9 of the Permanent Rules of the Council permits temporary rules to be established, that shall supersede a permanent rule for the time period as may be specified in the temporary rule; and

WHEREAS, Rule 6.11.1 provides that the Council President shall serve as a permanent chair of the Rules Committee and the Council President Pro Tem shall serve as vice chair of the Rules Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Council President has recommended that the City Council establish a temporary rule to provide that the President Pro Tem shall serve as the chairperson of the Rules Committee and the Council President serve as the vice-chair; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(1) this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter is exclusively within the purview of the City Council and not affecting the administrative service of the City under the control of the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following temporary rule is hereby adopted:

**Rule 6.11.1 Committee on Rules, Open Government and Intergovernmental**

**Relations** [new text underlined]

(a) The Committee on Rules, Open Government and Intergovernmental Relations (herein referred to as the Rules Committee) shall be composed of five voting members, the President, the President Pro Tem, and three other Councilmembers.

The President Pro Tem shall serve as the Chair and the President shall serve as the Vice-Chair.

(b) through (c) [no change in text.]

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the above temporary rule shall be effective and supercede Permanent Rule 6.11.1 from adoption and continuing until December 8, 2008 or until such time that the Permanent Rules of the City Council are amended to incorporate the subject matter addressed in the temporary rule.
