DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 18 2008

WHEREAS, The State of California, Department of Boating and Waterways [DBW] currently offers five forty hour modules of training in the area of boating rescue enforcement; and

WHEREAS, these courses are approved by the Port Captains and Harbor Masters Association; and

WHEREAS, DBW requested that the City of San Diego Fire-Rescue Department host two classes: Rescue Boat Operations and Marine Firefighting; and

WHEREAS, classes are open to agencies involved in boating safety, rescue and enforcement, including lifeguards, harbor police officers and other law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, by hosting these classes, qualified San Diego City employees will be able to attend without having to incur costs; and

WHEREAS, these classes are intended to provide training to City Lifeguards and other law enforcement agencies, and further the ultimate goal is to continue to protect the safety of mariners in the waters of the City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Authorize the Mayor or his designee to accept a reimbursement from the State Department of Boating and Waterways the amount of \$ 28,650. The reimbursement will be used to offset the costs incurred by the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department to hold two boating classes in Mission Bay.

2. Authorize the City Auditor and Comptroller to establish a special interest-bearing fund for this grant program.

3. Authorize the City Auditor and Comptroller to accept, appropriate and expend Funds from this grant program.
