
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
A 20 MILE PER HOUR SPEED LIMIT ON DUPONT STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That, pursuant to its authority under section 22358.3 of the California Vehicle Code, the Council finds, based on an engineering and traffic survey conducted by Staff of the Engineering and Capital Projects Department, that the prima facie speed limit of 25 miles per hour on Dupont Street between Catalina Boulevard and Silver Gate Avenue, a residence district, is more than is reasonable or safe, and a speed limit of 20 miles per hour is most appropriate.
2. That the establishment of a 20-mile per hour prima facie speed limit on Dupont Street between Catalina Boulevard and Silver Gate Avenue is authorized.
3. This activity is not a "project" and is therefore not subject to California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA], pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
