A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RATIFYING THE ELECTION RESULTS OF DECEMBER 11, 2007 FOR THE NORTH BAY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the elected members of the Project Area Committee have submitted to this City Council information establishing the qualifications of each person relative to district, category or organization as appropriate; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the North Bay Redevelopment Project Area Committee consisting of persons named on the list of Project Area Committee members receiving the highest number of votes

attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference is hereby approved as constituting a representative Project Area Committee.

2. That the Council hereby concurs that the election results of December 11, 2007 are valid and binding in accordance with the procedures adopted by Resolution No. R-289249.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this action has been determined through City review to not constitute a "project" under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
