

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 303365

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 11 2008

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department has provided the City Council with a proposed legislative program with a proactive list of legislative, budgetary and regulatory priorities for calendar year 2008 in both Sacramento and Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, the proposed legislative and administrative sponsorship priorities include storm water pollution prevention, water reliability, wildfire prevention, state grant notification, transportation and border funding; and

WHEREAS, the proposed program also highlights continuing legislative and funding priorities including implementation of the statewide infrastructure bonds, the Point Loma waiver, gang prevention funding, homeland security funding and the renewal of the community boundary correction; and

WHEREAS, the City Council discussed the proposed legislative program at its meeting on January 29, 2008; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council approves the State and Federal Legislative, Budgetary and Regulatory priorities for The City of San Diego for Calendar Year 2008, including the following specific items:

1. AED issues;
2. Gang prevention measures;
3. A requirement that a City Council hearing be held to prioritize projects prior to the City applying for Proposition 1C funds;

4. Seek funding for the IPR "toilet to tap" pilot program;
5. Support for eliminating the sunset provision for the San Diego River Conservancy;
6. Direction that the City ensure more communication and participation with the community involved or impacted when the City applies for grants, and provide information on the monitoring requirements costs for the grant money; and
7. Direction to staff to provide analysis on changing the law for the Border Development Zone.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the 2008 Legislative Program, as set forth in Intergovernmental Relations Department Report No. 08-004, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-303365 be and the same is hereby approved.


