WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is made up of over 120 identified community neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, each neighborhood has a name that seeks to identify it through a historical or geographical moniker; and

WHEREAS, the community formerly known as Darnall has met, discussed and has in a majority vote, changed its community neighborhood name to "Redwood Village"; and

WHEREAS, the name of police beat number 823 is no longer consistent with the name of either community that it serves; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes its neighborhoods to be identified in a manner that is consistent with the desires of the residents; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- That police beat number 823 which is bordered on the north by University Avenue, the west by 54th Street, the east by the City of La Mesa and on the south by Streamview Drive, College Avenue, and State Route 94 shall be renamed "Redwood Village/Rolando Park".
- 2. That the western side of police beat number 823 shall be officially referred to as "Redwood Village".
- 3. That the eastern side of police beat number 823 shall be officially referred to as "Rolando Park."
- 4. That all official references by City departments (including but not limited to Police, Fire, Redevelopment, and Planning) to the former neighborhood of Darnall shall be

retired and replaced with the aforementioned names of Redwood Village and Rolando Park.

5. That all city standard community identifying signs shall be changed to reflect this action.
