DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 19 2008

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING FUNDING FOR FY 2008 FOR THE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT AND BIKEWAY PEDESTRIAN PROJECTS.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego [City], as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and empowered for and on behalf of the City to apply for Transportation Development Act (TDA), and TransNet Bikeway Fund, grants from SANDAG for bicycle/pedestrian improvement projects [Projects.]
2. That the Mayor, or designee, is authorized and empowered to take all necessary actions to secure grant funds from SANDAG for the Project.
3. That the Fiscal Year 2008 Capital Improvements Program Budget is amended by adding CIP 58-207.0 – Bicycle rings and racks; CIP 58-206.0 – India Street Improvement Study; CIP 58-205.0 – Kearny Villa Road Bike Path Study.
4. That Fiscal Year 2008 Capital Improvements Program Budget is amended by increasing Fund 390071, TDA, by an amount not to exceed \$550,000 for the following projects: CIP 58-153.0 – Bicycle Master Plan Update - \$150,000; CIP 58-207.0 – Bicycle rings and racks - \$50,000; CIP 58-206.0 – India Street Improvement Study - \$50,000; CIP 58-205.0 – Kearny Villa Road Bike Path Study - \$100,000; CIP-58-201.0 – Safety in Traffic Education Program (STEP) Phase 2 - \$200,000.
5. That the appropriation and expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$550,000 from TDA, Fund 390071 for the following: CIP 58-153.0 – Bicycle Master Plan Update -

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
\$150,000; CIP 58-207.0 – Bicycle rings and racks - \$50,000; CIP 58-206.0 – India Street Improvement Study - \$50,000; CIP 58-205.0 – Kearny Villa Road Bike Path Study - \$100,000; CIP 58-201.0 – Safety in Traffic Education Program (STEP) Phase 2 - \$200,000, is authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the Projects, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement and upon the City Auditor and Comptroller first certifying that funds are on deposit with the City Treasurer.

6. That the City Auditor and Comptroller, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is not a “project” and is therefore exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(2). Any construction activities related to this approval will be subject to environmental review.

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
