A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE A AN IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS REGARDING THE BALLOT MEASURE ON EXEMPTING FROM THE MANAGED COMPETITION PROCESS THE CITY SERVICES PROVIDED BY PARTICIPANTS IN THE CITY'S SAFETY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 27.0505 allows the City Council to direct the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis of any proposed ballot measure; and

WHEREAS, at a meeting held on February 4, 2008, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 0-2008-0004 (N.S.), placing on the June 3, 2008 ballot the ballot measure to amend Article VII, section 117, of the San Diego City Charter to exempt from the Managed Competition process the core public safety services provided by police officers, firefighters, and lifeguards who participate in the City's Safety Retirement System; and


WHEREAS, the City Council's proposal, on its own motion, of a charter amendment is governed by California Constitution, article XI, section 3(b), California Elections Code section 9255(a)(2), and California Government Code section 34458, and is not subject to veto by the Mayor; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Attorney is directed to prepare an impartial analysis of the proposed ballot measure for inclusion in the voter
