City of San Diego, Case No 98-CV-688 – IEG [The Litigation], which resulted in a judgment for Plaintiffs, including an award of attorney's fees. The Litigation was timely appealed, styled as City of San Diego et al. v. George Isbell, Jr., Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals Civil Docket No. 07-56189 [The Appeal].

WHEREAS the City in closed session on November 6, 2007 authorized settlement of the Litigation and the Appeal for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Council authorizes:

1. The sum of \$100,000 to be paid from the public liability fund in settlement of each and every claim against the City, its agents and employees, arising from the Litigation and the Appeal.
