BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this authority includes the execution of all aspects of fund and program operation, including any amendments, extensions, augmentations, or renewals from the State of California for identical or closely related purposes; and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory or regulatory requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller are authorized to accept, appropriate and expend these funds up to \$2,532,156 if grant funding is secured.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this authorization shall be valid for a period of up to five years, provided funding for this purpose is made available by the State of California.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall be used to supplement and not to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
