WHEREAS, Peter Armstrong earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science and Women's Studies from Pomona College in 1994 and a Master of Planning degree from the University of Minnesota in 1996; and

WHEREAS, over the past ten years, Peter Armstrong has taken many continuing education courses in urban development, investment and land marketing from San Diego State University and the University of California, at San Diego; and

WHEREAS, in 1995, Peter Armstrong began his career in Minneapolis, Minnesota as a Community Program Specialist with the Twin Cities Metropolitan Growth Management Project; and

WHEREAS, after moving to San Diego in 1996, Peter Armstrong began work for the City of La Mesa as a Management Intern in the City Manager's office; and

WHEREAS, in 1997, Peter Armstrong accepted a position with Katz, Okitsu, and Associates as a Transportation Planner, where he drafted studies to assess the impact of proposed development on surrounding communities and the transportation system; and

WHEREAS, Peter Armstrong joined the City of San Diego's Neighborhood Code Compliance Department in 1998 as a Community Development Specialist, where he assisted property owners to obtain the technical and financial resources necessary to rehabilitate their properties; and

WHEREAS, in 1999, Peter Armstrong transferred to the Financing Services Department as an Associate Economist and, in 2001, advanced to Economist, where he was responsible for developing and reviewing financing mechanisms for projects proposed by the City's Redevelopment Agency, Economic Development Division and Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, Peter Armstrong began his work with the San Diego Housing Commission as a Project Manager, where he managed the issuance of housing revenue bonds and underwrote subordinate loans for affordable housing projects; and

WHEREAS, in 2006, as a Supervising Project Manager with the San Diego Housing Commission, Peter Armstrong also screened proposed projects for financial feasibility and compliance with federal, state and local requirements and provided technical assistance to developers and City departments; and

WHEREAS, Peter Armstrong received the Pomona College's Senior Service Award in 1994 and the San Diego Housing Foundation's John Craven Memorial Award in 2006 and Judgment Award in 2003; and

WHEREAS, after six years with the San Diego Housing Commission, Peter Armstrong is leaving to relocate in the Bay Area with his wife; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby commend Peter Armstrong for the imprint he has left on the City of San Diego through his efforts in redevelopment and affordable housing.

"PETER G. ARMSTRONG DAY" in the City of San Diego.
