A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS IN RESPONSE TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING & URBAN DEVELOPMENT'S (HUD) 2008 NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY FOR THE LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARD CONTROL AND LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION DEMONSTRATION GRANT PROGRAMS AND TO AUTHORIZE THE HOUSING COMMISSION'S PRESIDENT & CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS WITH HUD AND PARTICIPATING NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND CITY DEPARTMENTS TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANTS.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) publishes a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control and Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Programs for the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2008;

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission seeks to apply for approximately \$3 million in funding from the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Program and \$4 million in funding from the Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program to be implemented citywide in the City of San Diego on older residences likely to contain lead-based paint and occupied by low-income households with children; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Diego Housing Commission, on behalf of the City, is authorized to submit applications to HUD for the FFY 2008 Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant and the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Programs;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council does hereby find that the application for this grant is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA)

(R-2008-660)

pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) and from further review under the National Environmental Quality Act (NEPA) pursuant to 24 CFR 58.34(a)(12). If awarded, the lead-paint abatement activities funded under the grant will be conducted fully within the requirements of state and federal environmental laws, rules and regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council authorizes the Housing Commission's President and Chief Executive Officer, on behalf of the City, to execute all necessary documents and contracts with HUD and participating non-profit organizations and City Department to implement the grant(s).


