A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION AND SUBMISSION FOR THE 2008 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to make a submission for the 2008 Regional Transportation Improvement Program [RTIP], provided that the Euclid Avenue Corridor Improvements (CIP 52-743.0) is removed from this submission, and confirming that the City of San Diego is in compliance with the TransNet Ordinances as required by SANDAG and outlined in the resolutions.

2. That pursuant to Section 2 (C)(1) of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that no more than 30 percent of its annual revenues shall be spent on maintenance-related projects; and

3. That pursuant to Section 4 (E)(3) of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that all new projects, or major reconstruction projects, funded by TransNet revenues shall accommodate travel by pedestrians and bicyclists, and that any exception to this requirement permitted under the Ordinance and proposed, shall be clearly noticed as part of the City of San Diego's public hearing process.

4. That pursuant to Section 8 of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that it has included an amount of local discretionary funding for street and road purposes in its budget for this fiscal year that is at least equal to the most recently established

minimum maintenance of effort requirement adopted by SANDAG and that it intends to continue to do so in each year of the five-year period covered by the RTIP.

5. That pursuant to Section 9A of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that it will extract an amount of \$2,000 from the private sector for each new construction residential housing unit in that jurisdiction to comply with the provisions of the Regional Transportation Congestion Improvement Program [RTCIP].

6. That pursuant to Section 13 of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that it has established a separate Transportation Improvement Account for TransNet revenues with interest earned expended only for those purposes for which the funds were allocated.

7. That pursuant to Section 18 of the TransNet Extension Ordinance, the City of San Diego certifies that each project of \$250,000 or more will be clearly designated during construction with TransNet project funding identification signs.

8. That the City of San Diego certifies that all other applicable provisions of TransNet Extension Ordinance have been met.

9. That the City of San Diego agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the SANDAG, the San Diego County Regional Transportation Commission, and all officers and employees thereof against all causes of action or claims to local TransNet funded projects.

10. Monies budgeted for the Euclid Avenue Corridor Improvements (CIP 52-743.0) will remain in the budget with no preference being made for either a widening or retaining the current width of Euclid Avenue.

11. The Euclid Avenue Corridor Improvements (CIP 52-743.0) will be referred to Council Committee for further discussion on improvement alternatives for Euclid Avenue, and any resulting impacts on the surrounding community.


12. Notice shall be provided to residents along the Euclid Avenue project corridor prior to any hearings on the Euclid Avenue Corridor Improvements (CIP 52-743.0) by the Council Committee.

13. The City of San Diego has held a clearly noticed public hearing regarding its proposed list of projects prior to approval by Council in accordance with Section 5(A) of the TransNet Ordinance and Rule 7 of SANDAG Board Policy 31.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is not a "project" and is therefore not subject to CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
