

- (e) Furnish a tabulation of the number of votes given in each precinct;
- (f) Furnish a tabulation of the number of votes given in each Council district by precinct;
- (g) Complete any and all tasks related to the legal conduct of this election as required of the City Clerk upon the request of the City Clerk or the City Council.


