A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INITIATING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO GENERAL PLAN AND UPDATE OF THE MIDWAY-PACIFIC HIGHWAY CORRIDOR AND OLD SAN DIEGO COMMUNITY PLANS.

WHEREAS, the request for initiation of an amendment to the City of San Diego General Plan and update of the Midway-Pacific Highway Corridor and Old San Diego Community Plans originated with the City Planning & Community Investment Department; and

WHEREAS, the first step in this process is for the City Council to initiate an amendment to the City of San Diego General Plan and update of the Midway-Pacific Highway Corridor and Old San Diego Community Plans to allow staff to proceed with a comprehensive analysis of the various plan components, elements, and policies of both community plans and preparation of any necessary revisions to adopted documents; and


WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2) this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision and where the City Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council initiates the requested amendment to the City of San Diego General Plan and update of the Midway-Pacific Highway Corridor and Old San Diego Community Plans for the purpose of facilitating a

comprehensive analysis of the various plan components, elements, and policies of both community plans and preparation of any necessary revisions to adopted documents; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that approval of initiation of the community plan amendments is not a "project" and is therefore not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA], pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060 (c) (3).
