WHEREAS, to many in the LGBT community, the stagecoach logo that defines Wells Fargo Bank has come to also represent a company that staunchly supports human rights; and

WHEREAS, in the past twenty years, Wells Fargo Bank has donated more than \$15 million to LGBT non-profit organizations and has been recognized for six years in a row by Diversity Inc. as one of the "Top 50 Companies for Diversity;" and

WHEREAS, in 1998, Wells Fargo Bank set a notable example to other mainstream companies by extending its employee benefits package to domestic partners while locally supporting AIDS Walk San Diego, Mama's Kitchen, the LGBT Community Center and San Diego LGBT Pride; and

WHEREAS, through its exceptional support and involvement with the LGBT community, Wells Fargo Bank has earned an honorable score of 100 percent on the Human Rights Campaign Corporate Equality Index; and

WHEREAS, each year the San Diego LGBT Pride organization recognizes organizations that have contributed significantly to the LGBT community through their leadership, activism and fundraising efforts; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego LGBT Pride organization's "Stonewall Service Award" honor is awarded to a group, which may or may not identify as specifically gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgender, but which has stalwartly supported the LGBT community over an extended period of years and/or has made an exceptional contribution in the past year; and

WHEREAS, this year, the San Diego LGBT Pride organization recognizes Wells Fargo Bank as an important leader in the LGBT community and for its tireless effort toward the betterment of our local community; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby commend Wells Fargo Bank for the imprint it has had on San Diego's LGBT community.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that July 14, 2008, be and is hereby proclaimed to be, "WELLS FARGO BANK DAY" in the City of San Diego.
