A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT A DONATION OF \$26,000 TO SUPPLEMENT THE COST OF IN-PAVEMENT FLASHERS ON COAST BOULEVARD SOUTH.

WHEREAS, the Pacific Homes Foundation is donating \$26,000 to The City of San Diego [City] to supplement the cost of in-pavement flashers on Coast Boulevard South; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated project cost including design and construction is \$42,000 and the remaining funds for the project are budgeted in CIP 61-001.0 Traffic Control and Calming Measures Annual Allocation, and

WHEREAS, the City has been donated this money in an effort to improve safety for pedestrians crossing Coast Boulevard South, NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to accept the donation of \$26,000 donated by Pacific Homes Foundation on behalf of The City of San Diego into Fund 63022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED , that the Comptroller is authorized to increase the Fiscal Year 2009 Budget in CIP 61-001.0 Traffic Control Calming Measures-Citywide, Fund 63022, Private and Developers Contribution by \$26,000 for Traffic Control and Calming Measures-Citywide; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the appropriation and expenditure of \$26,000 from CIP 61-001.0, Traffic Control and Calming Measures-citywide, Fund 63022 Private and Developer Contributions, JO 61074, for installing in-pavement flashers on Coast Boulevard


South adjacent to the Casa De Mañana senior housing facility, contingent upon the Comptroller certifying that funds are available.


