A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR
FUNDING FOR CACTUS WREN HABITAT RESTORATION
AT BLACK MOUNTAIN OPEN SPACE PARK.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee, is authorized and empowered for and on behalf of the City to make an application to the Wildfire Habitat Incentives Program, a cost-sharing program administered by the Natural Resources Conservation Service of the United States Department of Agriculture for the Black Mountain Open Space Park Cactus Wren Habitat Restoration [Project].
2. That the Mayor or his designee, is authorized and empowered to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the Project.
3. Authorizing the City Auditor and Comptroller to accept, appropriate and expend funds up to \$73,128 for the purposes of the Project, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed agreement.
4. Authorizing the City Auditor and Comptroller to establish a special interest-bearing account for the federal funds if secured.

5. That this activity is categorically exempt from California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State Guidelines Section 15307.
