DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 1 8 2008

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code section 8300 et seq. and San Diego Municipal Code section 125.1010(c) provide for the summary abandonment or vacation of public service easements by resolution of the Council of the City of San Diego [City Council] where the easement does not contain public utility facilities and the easement has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated or acquired for five consecutive years immediately preceding the proposed abandonment; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owner has requested the abandonment of an unnecessary public service sewer easement in Parcels 2 and 3 of Parcel Map 4380, on file with the City Clerk as Document No. (R304392 O.R. as depicted on Drawing No. 20665-B to unencumber this property. Said public service sewer easement [Easement] is located in the Rancho Bernardo Community Plan Area, north of Rancho Bernardo Road at the northerly terminus of Bernardo Oaks Drive; and

WHEREAS, the Easement does not contain public utility facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Easement has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated or acquired for five consecutive years immediately preceding the proposed abandonment; and

WHEREAS, there is no present or prospective public use of the existing Easement, either for the facility or purpose for which it was originally acquired or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated; and

WHEREAS, the public will benefit from the action through improved utilization of the land made available by the abandonment; and

WHEREAS, the abandonment is consistent with all applicable land use plans; and WHEREAS, the public facility or purpose for which the easement was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by the abandonment or the purpose for which the easement was acquired no longer exists; and

WHEREAS, this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities); and

WHEREAS, the Easement was acquired at no cost to the City; and

WHEREAS, under Charter Section 280(a)(2), this Resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body, a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision, and the City Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for public hearing on NOV 1 8 2008, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego [City Council], that the City Council finds that with respect to the Easement to be summarily abandoned:

- (1) The Easement does not contain public utility facilities; and
- (2) The Easement has not been used for the purpose for which it was acquired for five consecutive years immediately preceding the proposed abandonment; and

- (3) There is no present or prospective public use for the Easement, either for the facility or purpose for which it was originally acquired or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated; and
- (4) The public will benefit from the action through improved utilization of the land made available by the abandonment; and
- (5) The abandonment is consistent with all applicable land use plans; and
- (6) The public facility or purpose for which the Easement was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by the abandonment or the purpose for which the Easement was acquired no longer exists.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council finds:

- 1. That the Easement located within Parcels 2 and 3 of Parcel Map 4380, as more particularly described in the legal description marked as Exhibit "A," and shown on Drawing No. 20665-B, marked as Exhibit "B," and on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document Nos. RR 304392, and RR 304392, which are by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered summarily abandoned.
- 2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution, with attached Exhibits, attested by her under Seal, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder. From and after the date of recordation of this Resolution, the abandoned public service easement shall no longer constitute a public service easement. Upon such recordation, the summary abandonment is complete.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council finds that this action is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities).
