BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby concurs that the election results of October 7, 2008 are valid and binding in accordance with the procedures so adopted by Resolution No. R-304042.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is not a "project" and is therefore not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
