BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the North Bay Redevelopment Project Area Committee candidates, consisting of the persons named on the list of Project Area Committee as those receiving the highest number of votes, as listed on the document attached hereto as Exhibit C, and incorporated herein by this reference, are hereby approved as constituting a representative Project Area Committee.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby concurs that the election results of October 7, 2008 are valid and binding in accordance with the procedures so adopted by Resolution No. R-289249.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is not a "project" and is therefore not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to the State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
