A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING FOR THE VACATION OF AN UNNEEDED DRAINAGE EASEMENT WITHIN PORTIONS OF LOT 8, 15 AND 16, BLOCK 6 OF MAP NO. 1216 OF LA JOLLA STRAND.

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code 8300 et seq. (and specifically Sections 8333 and 8335), and San Diego Municipal Code Section 125.1010(c) provides a procedure for the summary abandonment or vacation of public service easements by City Council resolution where the easement to be vacated has been superseded by relocation and there are no other public facilities located within the easement; and

WHEREAS, the affected property owner has requested the vacation of the unnecessary drainage easement within portions of Lots 8, 15 and 16, Block 6 of Map 1216 of La Jolla Strand as depicted on Engineering Drawing No. 20321-B to unencumber his property. Said drainage easement [easement] is located in the La Jolla Community Plan area, on the east side of La Jolla Boulevard north of Gravilla Street; and

WHEREAS, the existing public utility facilities located within the easement to be abandoned have been superseded with a new drain as shown on Engineering Drawing No. 33508-D; and

WHEREAS, there are no other public facilities located within the easement to be abandoned, and there is no present or prospective public use of the existing easement in its present location; and

WHEREAS, this action is not a project as defined in Section 15378, and therefore exempt from California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA], pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(b)(3); and.

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2) this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body and where a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision and where the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for public hearing on NOV 1 8 2008, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego finds that:

- 1. The drainage easement to be abandoned herein does not contain public utility facilities or does not contain active public utility facilities that would be affected by the abandonment.
- 2. The easement has been superseded by relocation and there are no other public facilities located within the easement.
- 3. There is no present or prospective public use for the easement, either for the facility or purpose for which it was originally acquired or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated.
- 4. The public will benefit from the action through improved utilization of the land made available by the abandonment.
 - 5. The abandonment is consistent with any applicable land use plan; and

6. The public facility or purpose for which the easement was originally acquired will not be detrimentally affected by the abandonment or the purpose for which the easement was

acquired no longer exists.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego finds as

follows:

1. That the drainage easement located within Lot 8, 15 and 16, Block 6 of Map 1216

of La Jolla Strand as more particularly described in the legal description marked as Exhibit "A,"

and as shown on Drawing No. 20321-B, marked as Exhibit "B," and on file in the office of the

_, and RR- 304401° which are by this City Clerk as Document Nos. RR- 304401

reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered summarily abandoned.

2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with attached

Exhibits, attested by her under seal, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder. From

and after the date of recordation of this Resolution, the abandoned public service easement shall

no longer constitute a public service easement. Upon such recordation, the abandonment is

complete.
