

WHEREAS, since May 2008, Inner City Youth, New Harvest, Reality Changers, Tariq Khamisa Foundation and over a hundred volunteers have been working with the Southeastern Police Division on community collaborative curfew sweeps; and

WHEREAS, volunteers from the District Attorney's office, the County's Child Protective Service, County Office of Education Court Schools, the YMCA, Jacobs Foundation, Probation, San Diego Unified School Police and Porter Elementary Staff along with many other committed community members; and

WHEREAS, these organizations and the volunteers stay up until 3 a.m. on Friday evenings working with officers to inform parents and counsel youth about the dangers and pitfalls of being out on the streets after curfew; and

WHEREAS, over 250 youth have been involved in the collaborative curfew sweeps and
Southeastern Police Officers have worked together as partners with the organizations; and

WHEREAS, Inner City Youth was founded to mobilize resources of the community for the safety and development of youth; and New Harvest Christian Fellowship works with parents and youth on a neighborhood focused basis; and Reality Changers works to improve youth members to a four year college; and Tariq Khamisa Foundation has reached over 70,000 youth in our community; and

WHEREAS, the collaborative curfew sweeps on a month basis will resume in January; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego does hereby proclaim December 2, 2008, as "COMMUNITY COLLABORATION DAY" in the City of San Diego
