A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REGARDING REPROGRAMMING OF FY 2009 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR ALL COUNCIL DISTRICTS AND CITYWIDE.

WHEREAS, on May 13, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-303662, in which the City Council authorized the City Auditor and Comptroller to accept CDBG funds in the amount of \$14,852,521 from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the City's FY 2009 Community Development Block Grant [CDBG] Program; and

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. R-303662, the City Council also approved the funding allocations and recommendations for the City's FY 2009 CDBG Program contingent upon certification of funds availability by the City Auditor and Comptroller.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the reprogramming of previously funded CDBG project balances from Citywide and each Council District which were not allocated as set forth in Report to the City Council 08-178, a copy of which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 304481, to new projects shall be placed back into their respective CDBG reserve accounts; contingent upon certification of funds availability by the City Comptroller.
2. That the City Comptroller is authorized to appropriate and expend the CDBG funds for the projects approved for funding as set forth in Report to the City Council 08-178, a


copy of which is on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 304481
contingent upon certification of funds availability by the City Comptroller.

3. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to negotiate and execute agreements with those CDBG projects approved for funding and submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) any amendments to the FY 09 Action Plan as required.

4. That the Comptroller is authorized to transfer the FY08 CDBG Administration balances to FY 09 CDBG Administration contingent upon certification of funds availability by the City Comptroller.

5. That the Comptroller is authorized to transfer the FY 07 Neil Good CUP allocation to be divided among Cortez Hill, Winter Shelter and the Neil Good Day Center contingent upon certification of funds availability by the City Comptroller
