

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 19836 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 03 2009

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O-19774 (NEW SERIES) ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2009 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR" BY AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF UP \$1,399,688.76 FROM FUND 10246, DEPT 121, FUND BALANCE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING ENHANCEMENTS TO THE CITY'S EMS SYSTEM AND AUTHORIZING SUCH EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2008, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. O-19774 entitled An Ordinance Adopting The Annual Budget For The Fiscal Year 2009 And Appropriating The Necessary Money To Operate The City Of San Diego For Said Fiscal Year [Appropriation Ordinance]; and

WHEREAS, Fund 10246, Dept 121, Fund Balance, contains revenue generated by the City's membership in SDMSE, the City's EMS service provider, and savings realized by the EMS System; and

WHEREAS, on December 4, 2006, the City Council adopted resolution R-302155 to change the SDMSE profit distribution policy and requested that staff return with recommendations on uses for such profit; and

WHEREAS, the Fire-Rescue Department has identified EMS system needs, as described in the accompanying executive summary;

WHEREAS, the Mayor has no veto power over this ordinance pursuant to Section 280(a)(4) of the City Charter; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


Section 1. That the Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended to appropriate up to \$1,399,688.76 from Fund 10246, Dept 121, Fund Balance.

Section 2. That the Comptroller is authorized to expend up to \$1,399,688.76 for the purpose of funding EMS system enhancements, as describe in the executive summary which is on file with the Clerk's office as document no. OO- 13836.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. This ordinance is declared to take effect and be in force immediately upon its final passage after two public hearings pursuant to the authority contained in sections 71, 275 and 295 of the Charter of the City of San Diego.
