
ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 19856 (NEW SERIES)



DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAY 9 1 2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE 6 BY AMENDING SECTION 86.11 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PARKING METER RATES.

WHEREAS, the Downtown Parking Management Group [DPMG] was formed in 2004; and

WHEREAS, the DPMG and City staff analyzed downtown parking issues extensively, and recommended the establishment of the Downtown Parking Pilot Program [Pilot]; and

WHEREAS, in November 2004 the Pilot was established pursuant to Council Resolution R-299867, and with two previous extensions, is set to terminate on April 30, 2009;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires this program to continue without interruption to allow for continuing evaluation; and, to that end enacts this ordinance to revive the Pilot and, if necessary to have retroactive application to the date of final adoption; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment and is therefore not subject to the California Environment Quality Act; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 8, Article 6 of the San Diego Municipal Code be amended by amending Section 86.11 to read as follows:

## §86.11 Parking Meter Zones and Rate – Authority

- (a) and (b) [No change in text.]
- (c) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the City Manager is authorized to establish a range for hourly parking meter rates from \$0.50 to \$1.25 within the Downtown Parking Pilot Program, as described in Resolution No. RR- 299867,

effective November 22, 2004, and terminating on October 31, 2009.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
