DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 2 2009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF SAN DIEGO COMMUNICATIONS DIVISION AND THE U.S. NAVY, FOR A CITY PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS FACILITY ON NAVY PROPERTY AT MT. SOLEDAD.

WHEREAS, the City operates a public safety emergency radio communications facility on Mt. Soledad, a U. S. Navy-owned site; and

WHEREAS, the facility serves as an integral part of the City's overall safety communications network; and

WHEREAS, the current lease terminates on May 31, 2009; and

WHEREAS, a new lease has been negotiated with an initial term of five years, with three five-year options to extend, for a total potential term of 20 years; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute a new five-year lease agreement between the City, as lessee, and the United States Navy, as lessor, with three additional five-year options to extend, to continue the City's use of its public safety emergency radio communications facility on Mt. Soledad, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 00- 19867.

Section 2. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.


