DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE 11 2 1 2009

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING CITY-OWNED LAND, KNOWN AS SEFTON FIELD, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK.

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter section 55 provides that all real property owned in fee by the City of San Diego [City] that is dedicated by ordinance for park and recreation purposes shall not be used for any but park and recreation purposes without a changed use or purpose being authorized by a two-thirds vote of the people; and

WHEREAS, the Mission Valley Community Plan provides that primary consideration for park development, including playing fields, should be given to the City property south of the YMCA currently being used by the Presidio Little League, known as Sefton Field; and

WHEREAS, on August 10, 2006, Mayor Jerry Sanders, Councilmember Donna Frye and Councilmember Kevin Faulconer announced the City's plan to transfer the approximately nineteen acres of Transportation Department land in Mission Valley known as Sefton Field to the City's Park and Recreation Department for the dedication of a new park to serve the residents of Mission Valley, Linda Vista and Old San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the proposed dedication site extends from the Mission Valley YMCA on the north to Interstate 8 Highway on the south, and is bordered by the Mission Valley Preserve on the west and commercial development to the east; and

WHEREAS, the Presidio Little League has developed and maintained the property as a recreational facility for over forty years, the property currently containing five baseball fields, a picnic area, concession stand, and parking areas; and

WHEREAS, the Presidio Little League currently holds a Preferential Nonexclusive Use and Occupancy Permit with the City, which requires the Presidio Little League to maintain the developed portion of the property at their sole cost and expense; and

WHEREAS, as funds become available, the site will be upgraded to provide additional park-like amenities and address other needs such as accessibility, at which time some maintenance responsibilities will shift from Presidio Little League to the Park and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, Council Policy 700-17 requires the Park and Recreation Board to review the City's inventory of park lands to determine which parks have met the requirements for dedication by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, a waiver of Council Policy 700-17 will allow the property known as Sefton Field to be dedicated as a park in a timely manner;

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has reviewed the City's NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- Section 1. That the parcel of City-owned land known as Sefton Field, which is more particularly described in Exhibits A and B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is set aside and dedicated in perpetuity for park and recreational purposes.
- Section 2. That the Council hereby specifically reserves the right to establish underground public service easements through and across the dedicated property so long as the

construction and maintenance of the subject easements do not substantially impact the

availability of the property for use for park and recreational purposes.

Section 3. That the Council waives the provision in Council Policy 700-17 requiring

the Park and Recreation Board to review the City's inventory of park lands to determine which

parks have met the requirements for dedication by ordinance.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final

passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day

prior to its final passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day

from and after its final passage.
