A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING
A GRANT APPLICATION AND RELATED ACTIONS WITH THE
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION REGARDING
RECYCLING PROGRAMS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2009 – 2013.

WHEREAS, the California Department of Conservation – Division of Recycling has grant funds available to local jurisdictions for enhanced recycling programs;

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego is eligible to apply for funds to purchase and install recycling containers and produce educational materials; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to apply for, negotiate with, execute agreements for, and accept grant funds from the California Department of Conservation – Division of Recycling, with one to five year terms for the implementation and/or enhancement of recycling programs by purchasing and installing recycling receptacles and by creating, producing, and distributing educational outreach materials for Fiscal Years 2009/2010 through and including Fiscal Year 2013/2014.

2. That the Environmental Services Department Director or the Deputy Director is designated as the person authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to conduct all grant negotiations and execute all grant documents, including but not limited to: applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests necessary to secure grant funding and to carry out and administer the City's obligations, responsibilities, and duties under the terms and conditions of the grant(s) for Fiscal Year 2009/2010 through and including Fiscal Year 2013/2014.

3. That contingent on the City's execution of grant agreement(s), the City Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend grant funds and to establish a separate fund to track expenditures and receive grant-related reimbursements for eligible expenditures.

4. That the City's grant application and acceptance activity is not a project and therefore is not subject to the California Environment Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(3); and that installing recycling receptacles and providing recycling educational programs is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15311.
