CHILDREN'S INITIATIVE DIVERSION PROJECT GRANT FUNDED EXPENDITURES

WHEREAS, the Children's Initiative Diversion Project [Project] is a non-profit organization under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3), the goal of which is to improve the well being of children and youth in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the Project builds and sustains strategic alliances with all sectors of the community, providing direct operational/organizational support, and technical assistance to community-based organizations, government institutions, schools, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Project works to keep children in school, improve youth decision making, and reduce youth contact with law enforcement and subsequent entrance into the juvenile justice system by using an innovative school/law enforcement diversion partnership; and

WHEREAS, through collaborative work with the San Diego Unified School District and San Diego Police Department [SDPD], the Project will implement diversion/intervention services to students identified as being at risk for dropping out and/or entering the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, SDPD agreed to serve as applicant and fiscal agent for the Project to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention [OJJDP] to fund salaries, supplies and operating expenses; and

WHEREAS, SDPD has been selected to receive a grant in an approximate amount of \$156,511 from OJJDP; and

WHEREAS, aside from approximately \$1,500 for mandatory travel expenses by an SDPD representative, SDPD wishes to subcontract the greater part of the grant funds to the Project; and

WHEREAS, there is no requirement for matching funds and no requirement to continue program operations or expenditures after grant funds are depleted for this Project; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee be and is hereby authorized and empowered for and on behalf of the City of San Diego, to apply for and accept a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in an approximate amount of \$156,511 for the Children's Initiative Diversion Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Comptroller be and is hereby authorized and empowered, to accept, appropriate and expend approximately \$156,511 in grant funds, if secured, and to establish a special-interest bearing account for the grant funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee be and is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement subcontracting the greater part of the grant funds to the Children's Initiative Diversion Project for program expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief of Police be and is hereby is authorized and empowered to administer and oversee this program.
