A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE SCRIPPS MIRAMAR RANCH COMMUNITY PLAN TO FACILITATE ADDITIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY RELATED FACILITIES AND ROADWAY RECLASSIFICATION IN THE SCRIPPS MIRAMAR RANCH COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2008 and December 4, 2007, the Council of the City of San Diego initiated amendments to the Scripps Miramar Ranch Community Plan and directed the Planning Department to prepare amendments which would identify the need for additional fire stations in the community to assure adequate response to the population, and reclassify Scripps Ranch Boulevard from a four-lane major street to a two-lane collector street between Carroll Canyon Road and Aviary Drive to allow for the construction of permanent street improvements including a raised and landscaped center median, on-street parking, class two bike lanes and sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Department has prepared an amendment to the community plan which states that all public safety related facilities (e.g. police, fire and emergency medical response) should be provided to assure levels of service standards are attained for existing development and as development occurs; and

WHEREAS, on October 16, 2008, the Planning Commission of the City of San Diego considered the proposed community plan amendments and pursuant to Resolution No. PC-08-114 voted to recommend City Council Approval of the community plan amendments; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for public hearing, testimony having been heard,

evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and

being fully advised concerning the same; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that this Council adopts

amendments to the Progress Guide and General Plan and the Scripps Miramar Ranch

Community Plan which adds language identifying the need to provide additional public safety

related facilities to serve existing development and as development occurs to assure adequate

response to the population, and for the reclassification of Scripps Ranch Boulevard from a four-

lane major street to a two-lane collector street between; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the amendment related to adding language for the

additional public safety facilities is not a "project" and therefore not subject to California

Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(2).

The amendment related to the reclassification of Scripps Ranch Boulevard from a four-lane

major street to a two-lane collector is exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines

Section 15301(c).
