## RESOLUTION NUMBER R-304707 DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE MAR 2 0 2009

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE "DESTINATION LINDBERGH REPORT" AND DIRECTING THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS DEPARTMENT TO SEEK FUNDING FOR SHORT-TERM SOLUTIONS NEEDED TO ADDRESS OFF-AIRPORT TRAFFIC AND CIRCULATION MITIGATION MEASURES RELATED TO THE AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, in 2008 the City Council authorized the Mayor to execute a Memorandum of Agreement [MOA] between the San Diego County Regional Airport Authority [Authority], the City of San Diego [City], and the San Diego Association of Governments regarding the San Diego International Airport [Airport] Master Plan and the Authority's Environmental Impact Report. The primary concern of the City at the time the MOA was entered into was the Authority's plan to construct a parking garage on the south side of the Airport without an adequate environmental review; and

WHEREAS, the parties to the MOA have come to an agreement on how to resolve the issues of concern and will memorialize their agreement by entering into an addendum to the MOA that includes the provision that the Authority will not proceed with the planning, development, or construction of the parking garage until the proposed parking garage goes through a new and complete environmental analysis; and

WHEREAS, City and Authority staffs have negotiated an additional Memorandum of Understanding [MOU] to facilitate the study, funding, and mitigation of off-airport traffic and

circulation mitigation measures which currently exist and/or will exist in the short-term of the future expansion of the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City will work cooperatively with the Airport Authority to seek funding for short-term solutions needed to address off-airport traffic and circulation mitigation measures related to the Airport; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Council accepts the "Destination Lindbergh Report."
- 2. That the Council directs that the Council's comments regarding the Destination

  Lindbergh Report be forwarded to the Airport Authority prior to the Airport

  Authority's next Board meeting.
- 3. That the Council directs the Intergovernmental Relations Department to seek funding for short-term solutions needed to address off-airport traffic and circulation mitigation measures related to the Airport.
